PIPELINE PRESENTATION SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

1. The abstract for the Pipeline (oral) Platform Presentation must adequately describe the objectives and results of all studies intended for the Pipeline (oral) Platform Presentation so that the quality of work can be evaluated by the Program Committee. The title of the abstract should be fully informative of the contents of the Pipeline (oral) Platform Presentation and the abstract and presentation should consist of: a) an introduction to the background and mechanism of action of any drug, technology, or device being presented and the purpose of all studies included in the presentation; b) a brief description of the procedures employed; c) a summary of the results; and d) a statement of the conclusions. In addition, the current stage of development and potential future preclinical and clinical development plans should be included in the abstract and in the final oral presentation.
2. The financial sponsor(s) of all studies should be listed at the end of all abstracts and the beginning of all selected presentations. All presenters must indicate whether or not they have a personal financial interest in the study sponsor(s) and, if so, the nature of the interest in their abstract and at the beginning of their presentation.
3. Receipt of abstracts will be acknowledged via e-mail to authors upon successful submission.
4. The Platform (oral) Pipeline Session will be held Friday, February 25, 2011 from 1:30 pm – 5:30 pm.
5. Slides for the final Platform (oral) Pipeline Session will be in Power Point format and the oral presentation should not exceed 6 minutes in length.
6. All presenters will be required to register for the meeting and pay all registration and travel costs, however, a one day registration fee will be available to Platform (oral) Pipeline Session presenters who attend only on the day of their presentation.
7. The deadline for submissions is Monday, February 7, 2011 at 11:59 pm.
